

PREPARING YOUR LOW-RES FILES FOR EDITING

- All images to be considered for edit must be shot in RAW format and be cleaned, cropped, corrected and loaded on the Spaces portal to be edited for the collection. These images should be sized at 1024 pixels on the long side, JPG level 12, Adobe RGB 1998, with a minimum resolution of 75 dpi.
- 2. You will receive an email stating that your submission has been edited by the Spac es editors with notes of any requested changes.

PREPARING YOUR FINAL HIGH-RES FILES

- 1. Log on to the portal and view the requested changes. After completing the changes on your RAW version, create a 100 MB 16-bit TIFF version for your own storage and backup (2 locations suggested).
- 2. Convert your 16-bit TIFF to an 8-bit 48-52 MB, JPG level 12, Adobe RGB 1998, with a resolution of 300 dpi. The histogram must be set between 5 and 250.

PREPARING PROPERTY & MODEL RELEASES

- Releases must have a visual reference attached in the designated box.
 Scan or photograph the release, the file should be at least 1 MB, JPEG, Adobe RGB 1998 with a minimum resolution of 75 dpi.
- 2. Name each separate release, using either property location or model name.
